

# Design a Doughnut

## Amazing Fact

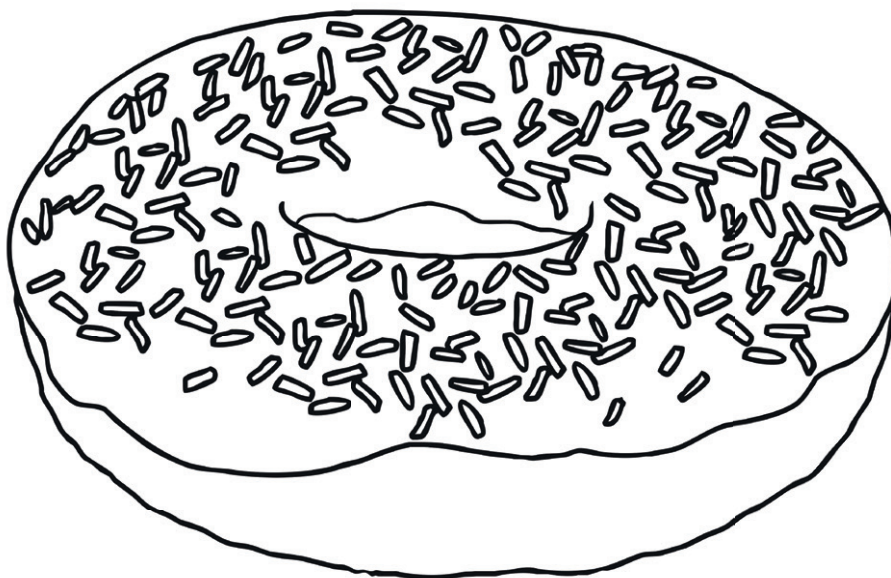
On the 5th December, 2007, staff at Donut King, Sydney, Australia, built a huge doughnut out of 90,000 regular-sized doughnuts. The sculpture took 40 people 9 hours to make and used 1 tonne of pink icing and 30kg of sprinkles.

## Challenge

Imagine you have been approached by Donut King to design a limited-edition Christmas doughnut. Create a poster, which will be displayed in the shop window at Donut King, advertising your limited-edition Christmas doughnut.

Remember to:

- include enticing noun phrases that describe the flavours and ingredients;
- describe what the doughnut tastes, smells and looks like;
- use snappy slogans and rhetorical questions to draw the reader in;
- use exaggeration to make the product appealing.

- when doughnuts were invented;
- what the longest line made of doughnuts is;
- what the most popular type of doughnut is in your country.

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
