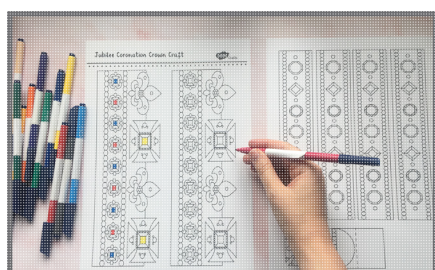


Jubilee Crown Craft



You will need:

- A copy of our templates printed onto card
- Extra sheet of card
- Glue or double-sided sticky tape
- Scissors
- Colourful pens or pencils
- Stapler



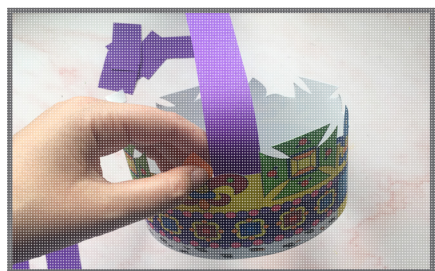
1) First, decorate the printed templates with colourful pens or pencils. You can choose a colour scheme or make your design as colourful as possible.



2) Then cut out each of the elements.



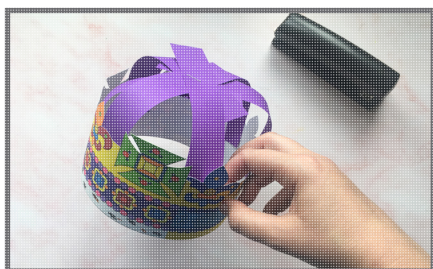
3) Next, take the two bands from the first sheet of the template pack and attach them together to create the main crown band.



4) Next, get your extra piece of colourful card. Cut a long strip along the whole length of the card. Now use glue or double-sided sticky tape to attach this long strip of card inside the crown.



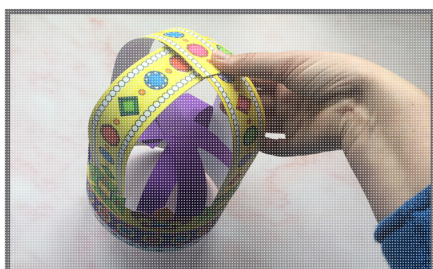
5) Then attach the other end of the strip to the opposite inside edge of the main headband. The ends of the strip should line up with the bottom edge of the headband.



6) You can now choose to add more strips under this main strip to create a dome but this is not essential. Avoid sticking any strips over the square crosses in the main headband.



7) Next, attach the four strips from the second sheet of the template pack so one end of each strip sits behind one of the square crosses of the main headband.



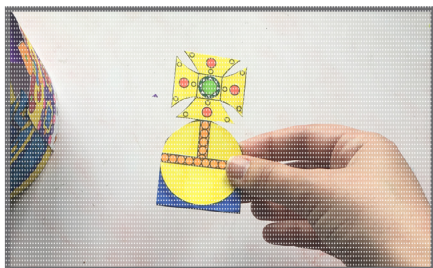
8) Now, use a stapler to attach the top of each of these strips together in a dome shape.



9) Then, push this centre point down to attach these decorated strips to the top of the smaller card strip dome you made earlier.



10) You will have created this lovely crown shape.



11) Next get the final element from the template pack. Fold along the dashed line to create a glue tab.



12) Choose where you would like the front of the crown to be and then secure this top element so it faces in this direction with a bit of glue or double-sided sticky tape.



13) You have created a wonderful Jubilee crown craft.
