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Multiplying Fractions

$$1) \quad \frac{5}{7} \times \frac{8}{10} = \frac{5 \times 8}{7 \times 10} = \frac{40}{70} = \frac{4}{7}$$

$$2) \quad \frac{2}{3} \times \frac{1}{6} = \frac{2 \times 1}{3 \times 6} = \frac{2}{18} = \frac{1}{9}$$

$$3) \quad \frac{2}{10} \times \frac{4}{7} = \frac{2 \times 4}{10 \times 7} = \frac{8}{70} = \frac{4}{35}$$

$$4) \quad \frac{5}{7} \times \frac{8}{10} = \frac{5 \times 8}{7 \times 10} = \frac{40}{70} = \frac{4}{7}$$

$$5) \quad \frac{3}{6} \times \frac{5}{10} = \frac{3 \times 5}{6 \times 10} = \frac{15}{60} = \frac{1}{4}$$

$$6) \quad \frac{2}{4} \times \frac{2}{6} = \frac{2 \times 2}{4 \times 6} = \frac{4}{24} = \frac{1}{6}$$

$$7) \quad \frac{5}{7} \times \frac{2}{3} = \frac{5 \times 2}{7 \times 3} = \frac{10}{21}$$

$$8) \quad \frac{6}{7} \times \frac{1}{4} = \frac{6 \times 1}{7 \times 4} = \frac{6}{28} = \frac{3}{14}$$

$$9) \quad \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{2}{6} = \frac{1 \times 2}{2 \times 6} = \frac{2}{12} = \frac{1}{6}$$

$$10) \quad \frac{1}{2} \times \frac{3}{9} = \frac{1 \times 3}{2 \times 9} = \frac{3}{18} = \frac{1}{6}$$
