



Halloween Run Around Quiz Teaching Ideas

Learning Objective: To learn about fear and why we feel this emotion.

Success Criteria:

- To identify information in a text.
- To work effectively within a group to achieve a shared goal.

Run Around Quiz

Introduce the 'Runaround Quiz' to the class. Students will be in groups of three (if possible).

In each group of three, each student will have a role:

Runner - their job is to come up to the front to get the question for the quiz from the teacher.

Reader - When the runner returns with the question, the Reader needs to scan through **Fact Sheet** and retrieve the right answer.

Writer - When the Reader has found the answer from the text, the Writer should write the answer on their answer sheet (just a blank piece of A4 is fine - just ask them to number their answer) and give it to the runner.

The runner will return to the teacher and show them the answer they have written down. If the answer is correct, the teacher will give the next question. If the answer is not correct, the original question will be repeated again. The winners are the first group to give all the answers to the teacher.

The questions have been differentiated (**Question and Answer Sheets**) and in addition, the **Fact Sheet LA** is a lower ability version that has a shorter text and some of the answers in bold to make it easier for the answer to be located.

Question Activity

Use the **Question Activity** to test students with a GCSE-style question. The **Question Activity Answers** sheet includes possible answers.
