She was used to performing the 'Disappearing Diamonds' trick with her husband, so she was able to spirit away the jewels without anyone noticing.	She was visiting the tower with her tourist party at the time of the crime.
Raphael Ramone		He had a large school bag which could have transported the crown jewels out. He is also extremely clever and good at finding solutions to difficult problems.	He was visiting the crown jewels with his school at the time of the crime.
