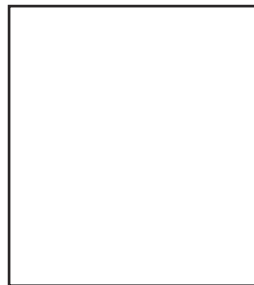
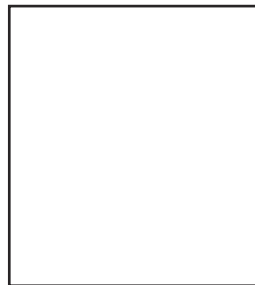
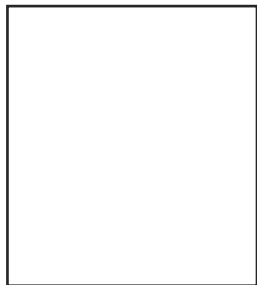
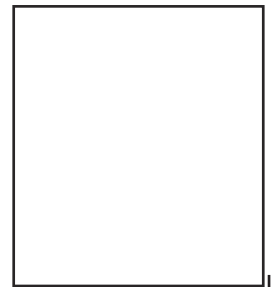
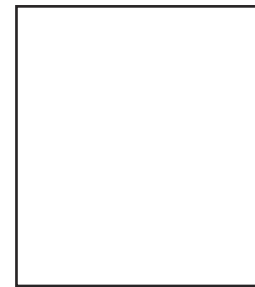
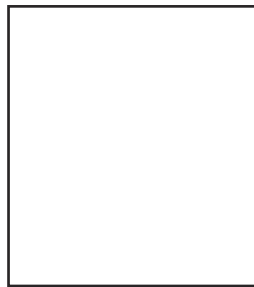
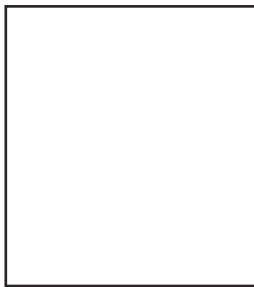
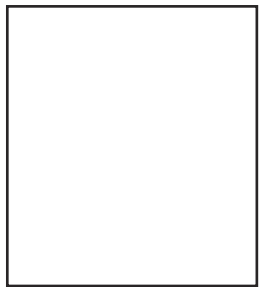


Ancient Greece Timeline Ordering
